#### **Current Position**

#### Reasons

- 1. The equipment should be competitive for a wide range of sailor weights; the equipment should demand high levels of skill and athletic ability.
- 2. The equipment should be modern in appearance and when sailing visually appealing live and on screen.
- 3. Cost of campaigning is a significant consideration for the sport, with both gender competing with the same hull, spars and foils there are a number of key cost centres that can be shared, such as coaching and spare equipment.
- 4. There should be an established base of available equipment to allow the equal and quick adoption by all nations.
