Proposal

Option 1

Change, from 2021 Youth Sailing World Championships, the Two Person Dinghy events from one boys and one girls to one mixed as follows:

(a) Boy's One Person Dinghy - Laser Radial Girl's One Person Dinghy - Laser Radial Boy's Two Person Dinghy 420 Girl's Two Person Dinghy 420

Reasons

- 1. As the 2024 two person dinghy Olympic event will be a mixed event, the Youth Sailing World Championships Boys and Girls two person dinghy events should be changed to align with the Olympic events for 2024.
- 2. Option 1 and 2 will strengthen the pathway in mixed sailing.
- 3. The Events Committee and the Youth Events Sub-Committee will discuss Option 1 and 2 at the 2019 annual meeting and the Events Committee will make a recommendation to Council at that time.
